SECOND TIME ATTENDEE SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA & SCORE SHEET

OBJECTIVE

To provide an opportunity for 4 members (1 per region) to receive a scholarship valued at the annual conference early bird registration fee to assist with expenses to attend the NAE4-HYPD Annual Conference.

ELIGIBILITY

- Applicant must have attended the previous NAE4-HPYD Annual Conference as an Association Member and attended the First Timer Orientation.
- Applicant must be a member the year applying for the scholarship
- Applicant must attend the NAE4-HPYD Annual Conference in the Fall of the year selected. If applicant selected does not attend, they will not receive the scholarship. The scholarship is reimbursed following the conference.
- If a selected applicant decides they are unable to attend, they are to notify the Public Relations & Information Chair for the region's alternate to be notified

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

- The application for Second Time Attendee will be included in the SPECIALTY AWARD SECTION.
- Applications will be submitted through the NAE4-HPYD Online Awards Portal. Awards will be judged at a national level by the New Professional Outreach Working Group.
- Applicants will submit directly to the national level. One recipient will be selected from each region with 8 alternates per region named to fill the open spot should the first place applicant not be able to use their scholarship. Winners will be contacted to verify they will accept scholarship and attend conference. If there are applicants who cannot attend, the slot will be offered to the first alternate listed.
- Required Information in application:
 - Contact Information Name, Full Address, email, office phone
 - Region (North Central, North East, Southern or Western)
 - Current Extension Job Title
 - Current percentage of 4-H appointment in current position
 - Total years of Extension employment with 4-H responsibility
 - Number of years of NAE4-HPYD membership, including current year
- Questions:
 - Are you a registered member of NAE4-HYDP? (point value = 10)
 - Have you applied to present a session, poster, or award? (point value = 10)

- Did you join a committee or a working group at NAE4-HYDP last year? If so, what have you done so far with your committee/working group? (point value = 10)
- Are you a member of your state association leadership (i.e. committee chair, officer)? (point value = 10)
- Did you take something you learned at your first conference and share with other staff in your state? If so, how did you share this? (point value = 20)
- Did you learn something at the last conference that you put into use in your own program? If so, what did you implement? (point value = 20)
- Why do you think you are deserving of this scholarship? (point value = 10)
- What would you tell a potential first time conference attendee about your first conference? (point value = 10)
